Project Proposal

Patriot was asked to deliver pipe cutting machines of various sizes in the period Q3 '19 until Q2 '20 with the aim of removing all piping on the platform's Tyra East and West. In this case Total decided to make use of the Patriot rental service and where our pipe cutters were operated by third parties. During this operation, flexibility, a large stock of machines and having our own logistics service proved to be of great importance.

What was the reason behind the project?

The Total platform's Tyra East and West in the Danish North Sea needed to be stripped of all their piping so they could be decommissioned.
